Dear Mr. MacNeith:

I am writing you regarding Waco Transit System's FY2022-2024 DBE program goal.

For firms other than fuel vendors, there were 185 DBE's in the Texas Unified Certification Program (Waco District/McLennan County) and 4,963 total firms in the Waco, Texas MSA. The source for the data for all the firms was also the Texas Unified Certification Program and WTS has attached the screen shot with the total number listed in the top right corner as well. Therefore, the relative availability percentage of DBE firms is 3.73% making up 98.9% of purchases. The anticipated goal for purchases other than fuel therefore is 3.69%. The 185 firms include printing, environmental study for parking lot project, construction for a possible parking lot project, motor vehicle supplies & parts merchants, general industrial suppliers, transportation equipment & supplies, vending machine operators, office supplies, payroll services, temporary help services, graphic design services, carpet cleaning, advertising services, clothing stores, bus body manufacturers, sign printing services, CPR, disaster relief services, education for drivers, and laundry services.

For fuel vendors there was 1 DBE in the Texas Unified Certification Program and 4 total firms in our Directory. Therefore, the relative availability percentage of DBE firms is 25% making up 1.1% of our purchases a year. The anticipated goal for fuel purchases is 0.28%.

$25\% = 1 \text{ DBE} / 4 \text{ Firms in Directory}$

The overall anticipated goal for DBE procurement for FY 2022 therefore equals 3.97% (3.69% + 0.28%).

Currently, Waco Transit System does not have any subcontracting opportunities, or sub recipients at this time. At this time no vehicle procurements are scheduled during the 2022-2024 period, because the agency is researching opportunities to

start transitioning into an electric fleet. If this changes, WTS will contact FTA and inform them of any vehicle procurements expected.

No comments were received from the public and the goal is now added to the website per the FTA's request.

Waco Transit System found no demonstrated evidence indicating that the availability of DBE's for DOT-assisted contracts for the fiscal year was higher or lower than the base figure indicates. The Waco area has offered WTS and the surrounding areas with very limited DBE's in previous years and in comparison only increased by 68 in the three year time period of the previously approved goal. Also, our goal for FY22-24 only decreased by .01% which is insignificant in measure when compared to the previous approved goal of 3.98%. Therefore, no adjustment was found to be necessary to the anticipated goal of 3.97% computed above.
