## Safety Equipment

All swimming pools must have rescue and safety equipment available <u>WITHIN</u> 20 FEET of the pool. Safety equipment must always be in the pool enclosure and may not be put away at night or during the off season.

## **Shepherd's Hook**

A shepherd's hook or reaching pole must be one continuous piece, at least 12 feet long and can only be made out of fiberglass, or other material that does not conduct electricity. Metal poles are not allowed.

## **Buoy/Life Ring**

Buoys must be U.S. Coast
Guard approved. The
throwing rope shall be 1/4
to 3/8 inch thick in
diameter. The length of
the rope must be at
least 2/3 of the
maximum pool's width.

## **Emergency Telephone**

A hardwired emergency telephone is required, must be operational and must dial directly to 911. The phone must be available within an unimpeded distance of 200 feet. A gate that is unlocked or a pool fence or gate that is locked, but is less than 4 feet 4 inches tall are not impediments. A locked gate that is taller than 4 feet 4 inches is an impediment, so the phone most be located on the
